

#New Testament Commandments Part 4 – NASB  
#151-200, Luke 15:12 to John 18:4

#151 Luke 15:12 “This is My commandment, that you love one another, just as I have loved you

#152 Luke 15:16 You did not choose Me but I chose you, and appointed you that you would go and bear fruit, and that your fruit would remain, so that whatever you ask of the Father in My name He may give to you

#153 Luke 15:17 This I command you, that you love one another

#154 Luke 16:18 Everyone who divorces his wife and marries another commits adultery, and he who marries one who is divorced from a husband commits adultery

#155 Luke 17:10 So you too, when you do all the things which are commanded you, say, ‘We are unworthy slaves; we have done only that which we ought to have done

#156 Luke 17:31 On that day, the one who is on the housetop and whose goods are in the house must not go down to take them out; and likewise the one who is in the field must not turn back

#157 Luke 17:32 Remember Lot’s wife

#158 Luke 21:9 When you hear of wars and disturbances, do not be terrified; for these things must take place first, but the end does not follow immediately

#159 Luke 21:28 But when these things begin to take place, straighten up and lift up your heads, because your redemption is drawing near

#160 Luke 21:31-32 So you also, when you see these things happening, recognize that the kingdom of God is near. Truly I say to you, this generation will not pass away until all things take place.

#161 Luke 21:34 “Be on guard, so that your hearts will not be weighted down with dissipation and drunkenness and the worries of life, and that day will not come on you suddenly like a trap;

#162 Luke 21:36 But keep on the alert at all times, praying that you may have strength to escape all these things that are about to take place, and to stand before the Son of Man.”

#163 Luke 22:17-18 He said, “Take this and share it among yourselves; for I say to you, I will not drink of the fruit of the vine from now on until the kingdom of God comes

#164 Luke 22:19 And when He had taken some bread and given thanks, He broke it and gave it to them, saying, “This is My body which is given for you; do this in remembrance of Me

#165 Luke 22:26 But it is not this way with you, but the one who is the greatest among you must become like the youngest, and the leader like the servant.

#166 Luke 22:40 Pray that you may not enter into temptation

#167 Luke 22:46 “Why are you sleeping? Get up and pray that you may not enter into temptation

#168 John 2:16 stop making My Father’s house a place of business.

#169 John 3:3 “Truly, truly, I say to you, unless one is born again he cannot see the kingdom of God

#170 John 4:24 God is spirit, and those who worship Him must worship in spirit and truth.”

#171 John 5:8 Jesus \*said to him, “Get up, pick up your pallet and walk.”

#172 John 5:23 He who does not honor the Son does not honor the Father who sent Him.

#173 John 5:24 “Truly, truly, I say to you, he who hears My word, and believes Him who sent Me, has eternal life, and does not come into judgment, but has passed out of death into life.

#174 John 6:27 Do not work for the food which perishes, but for the food which endures to eternal life, which the Son of Man will give to you, for on Him the Father, God, has set His seal.

#175 John 6:29 Jesus answered and said to them, “This is the work of God, that you believe in Him whom He has sent.

#176 John 8:12 “I am the Light of the world; he who follows Me will not walk in the darkness, but will have the Light of life.”

#177 John 8:24 Therefore I said to you that you will die in your sins; for unless you believe that I am He, you will die in your sins.”

#178 John 8:39 Jesus \*said to them, “If you are Abraham’s children, do the deeds of Abraham.

#179 John 8:51 Truly, truly, I say to you, if anyone keeps My word he will never see death.”

#180 John 9:4 We must work the works of Him who sent Me as long as it is day; night is coming when no one can work.

#181 John 11:26 and everyone who lives and believes in Me will never die.

#182 John 11:44 “Unbind him, and let him go.”

#183 John 13:14 If I then, the Lord and the Teacher, washed your feet, you also ought to wash one another’s feet

#184 John 13:34 A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another, even as I have loved you, that you also love one another

#185 John 14:1 “Do not let your heart be troubled; believe in God, believe also in Me

#186 John 14:11 Believe Me that I am in the Father and the Father is in Me; otherwise believe because of the works themselves

#187 John 14:21 He who has My commandments and keeps them is the one who loves Me; and he who loves Me will be loved by My Father, and I will love him and will disclose Myself to him

#151-200, Luke 15:12 to John 18:4

#188 John 14:23 If anyone loves Me, he will keep My word; and My Father will love him, and We will come to him and make Our abode with him.

#189 John 14:27 Do not let your heart be troubled, nor let it be fearful.

#190 John 14:28 If you loved Me, you would have rejoiced because I go to the Father, for the Father is greater than I.

#191 John 15:4 Abide in Me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself unless it abides in the vine, so neither can you unless you abide in Me.

#192 John 15:5 I am the vine, you are the branches; he who abides in Me and I in him, he bears much fruit, for apart from Me you can do nothing.

#193 John 15:7 If you abide in Me, and My words abide in you, ask whatever you wish, and it will be done for you.

#194 John 15:9 Just as the Father has loved Me, I have also loved you; abide in My love.

#195 John 15:12 “This is My commandment, that you love one another, just as I have loved you.

#196 John 15:16 You did not choose Me but I chose you, and appointed you that you would go and bear fruit, and that your fruit would remain, so that whatever you ask of the Father in My name He may give to you.

#197 John 15:17 This I command you, that you love one another.

#198 John 15:26 When the Helper comes, whom I will send to you from the Father, that is the Spirit of truth who proceeds from the Father, He will testify about Me, and you will testify also, because you have been with Me from the beginning.

#199 John 16:4 Until now you have asked for nothing in My name; ask and you will receive, so that your joy may be made full.

#200 John 18:4 Whom do you seek?
